R. James Rockwell, Jr. Educational Achievement Award

Objective

To recognize outstanding contributions in laser safety education. Examples of fields of contribution include the following:

- Significant involvement in conventional training and educational courses
- Publications including books, journal articles, pamphlets
- Development of significant software
- Significant involvement in laser safety–related conferences
- Development of on-line training and educational courses
- Development of significant education web sites (traditional or non-traditional)

Eligibility

Nominations are open to candidates who make outstanding contributions to laser safety education. Candidates may be individuals, organizations, groups, and institutions of higher education. Candidates do not have to be a member of the LIA, but sustained service to the LIA can be one of the additional contributions that is considered. Nominations are active for two years. Self nomination is not allowed.

Endowment & Support

The award is supported on a biennial basis by LightRay Consulting, although the society has a goal to establish a permanent endowment for the Award.

Nature of the Award:

The award consists of \$500.00 and a plaque citing the contribution made by the recipient. The Award will be presented biennially at the International Laser Safety Conference (ILSC).

Selection Procedure:

- 1) Any LIA member can nominate.
- 2) The LIA Awards Committee will solicit and review nominations and recommend a recipient on the basis of the information provided. This recommendation will be forwarded to the LIA Executive Committee for review and final approval.
- 3) The nominator must document the nominee's contribution to the field of laser safety education. Factors that may be considered include excellence, uniqueness, innovativeness, impact, sustainability, quality, and benefit to the profession. The documentation should be a maximum of three pages.
- 4) The nomination should include supporting letters from at least two prominent individuals in the field of laser safety.
- 5) Nominations are active for two years, including one ILSC.
